Endow a Named Scholarship

MCLE's named scholarship program honors those whose lives and work exemplify the best of Massachusetts' rich legal heritage.

MCLE's named scholarship program serves two purposes: providing essential funding for scholarships and honoring members of the bar and bench in a lasting and meaningful way. The program commemorates Massachusetts attorneys and judges who have, for example, demonstrated special concern for the rights of litigants, taken time to encourage young lawyers who lacked confidence in their abilities, or worked to ensure that legal services would be available to all members of the Commonwealth.

MCLE invites suggestions from members of the bar regarding scholarship honorees, and will work with volunteers to raise the \$25,000 minimum fund amount needed to establish a named scholarship. A gift fund of \$25,000 yields ten scholarships every year—in perpetuity!
