#### Mandatory CLE credits

States have varying mandatory CLE credit requirements; individual attorneys are responsible for checking with their particular state CLE accreditation authority about whether and how much credit will be granted. It is the responsibility of the individual attorney interested in CLE credit to submit the information and certifications required under the respective state rule to the appropriate state authorities in the jurisdictions in which they seek credit.

Depending on the jurisdiction, lawyers can satisfy their mandatory CLE requirements online with MCLE's webcasts, which feature periodic attendance prompts, online written materials, and the opportunity to receive a certificate of attendance.
